Notice: School Reopening on June 1

We would like to express our sincere gratitude for your constant support. On this occasion, we are contacting you to announce that if the "state of emergency" is lifted, schools will reopen on June 1.

Please be aware that this may change, depending on the Coronavirus situation in Yokohama city. We will inform you if that is the case.

1 School reopening will be in stages

(1) Schedule

- First stage: June 1 (Monday) to June 12 (Friday).

Students will attend at different times. ^{bunsantoukou} (分散登校)

They attend at a half-day short class.

June 2nd, anniversary of the opening of the port, will not be a holiday.
There will be classes on that day.

There will be no school lunch. Students will eat lunch at home.

- Second stage: June 15 (Monday) to June 30 (Tuesday).

There will short, half-day classes, in the morning or the afternoon.

There will be also no school lunch. Students will eat lunch at home.

(2) Safety measures during class.

- Windows will be kept open during classes.
- Students will not be able to gather in small places.
- Students will be asked not to talk or speak loudly near other people.
- Masks should be used
- We will encourage the washing of hands and gargling habitually.

2 About the first stage of school

- Grades and classes will be divided into groups to attend school.
- Students will spend half-day at school, either in the morning or the afternoon.
(Half day classes)
- The groups are going to be divided in the following way.

4 Monitoring your child's health
